Epic Namibia

12 days, set departures March to December. Group departure, Monday through Friday. A good choice for a quality, affordable safari.

Namibia by Air

9 days, year round departures any day of the week. This is a private-guided safari, with in-country air transfers and a private vehicle. Excellent tour for photographers and travelers who prefer a private vehicle.

Skeleton Coast

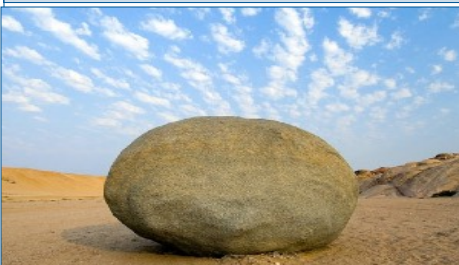
6 days, May to September. Travel to remote northern Namibia to see rare, desert-adapted wildlife: elephants, rhinos, lions and more. Stay in a newly opened safari camp in the Skeleton Coast reserve. This trip is easily added to Epic Namibia or any Botswana trip.

Epic Namibia

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Designed for travelers who want to explore a cross section of this beautiful and fascinating desert country, including the coastal region.

Day 1: Arrive Windhoek, transfer Galton House or similar

Day 2: Depart Windhoek with your guide, driving through the Great Escarpment into the Namib Desert, arriving at Sossus Dune Lodge in the afternoon. L,D

Day 3: Enjoy the day taking a variety of game drives through the NamibRand Nature Reserve in Sossusvlei. O/N Sossusvlei Dune Lodge B,L,D

Day 4: Drive through the impressive desert landscapes of the Namib Naukluft National Park, then depart for the charming, German-founded coastal resort of Swakopmund. O/N Guest House B,L,D

Day 5: Head to Walvis Bay in the morning for kayaking, looking for birdlife, Cape fur seals, dolphins, pelicans, flamingos and other sea birds, then return to Swakopmund to explore the town on your own. O/N Guest House B,L,D

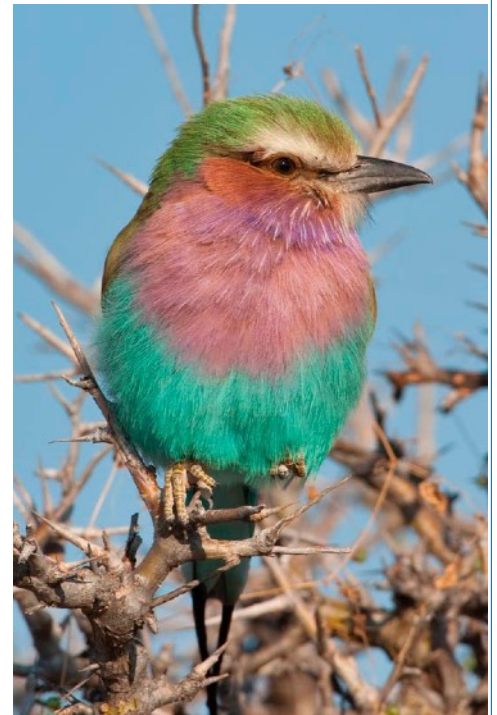
Day 6: Drive into the heart of Damaraland, stopping at the World Heritage site of Twyfelfontein to see prehistoric rock carvings, and the geologic wonders of Burnt Mountain and Organ Pipes. O/N Camp Kipwe B,L,D

Day 7: Explore Damaraland, driving through the Aba Huab River Valley, searching for the elusive desert adapted elephants. O/N Camp Kipwe B,L,D

Day 8: Drive to the famous Etosha National Park, stopping at a remote Himba village. O/N Etosha Mountain Lodge B,L,D

Day 9: Spend the day viewing game in Etosha National Park, habitat for lions, rhinoceros, elephants, and zebras. O/N Onguma Tree Top Camp B,L,D

Day 10: Explore the eastern section of Etosha, photographing and watching wildlife that congregate at the waterholes. Evening game drive on the Onguma Game Reserve, home to over 30 different animal species and 300 bird species. Onguma Tree Top B,L,D



Day 11: Visit the Okonjima Day Center for a short game drive and a tour of the African Foundation, stopping at the local craft market in Okahandja before returning to Windhoek. Arrive at Galton House or similar in the late afternoon. B,L

Day 12: Transfer to airport (included) for flights home.



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Namibia by Air

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A great option for travelers who want to see as much of Namibia as possible in just one week. Fly the long distances, then tour in your private vehicle with your own guide.

Day 1: Arrive Windhoek, transfer to hotel (included). O/N Galton House or similar D

Day 2: Fly to Sossusvlei Desert Lodge. Take an afternoon game drive to NamibRand Nature Reserve or relax and enjoy the scenery. O/N Sossusvlei Desert Lodge B,L,D

Day 3: Rise early to enter the park at sunrise as the soft morning light accentuates the towering shapes of the dunes. O/N Sossusvlei Desert Lodge B,L,D

Day 4: Fly into Damaraland, over the massive Sossuvlei dunes. See prehistoric rock engravings at the World Heritage site of Twyfelfontein, explore the wildly colorful and unique geologic formations of Burnt Mountain and the Organ Pipes. O/N Mowani Mountain Camp B,L,D

Day 5: On game drives today we will search for herds of desert adapted elephants and other wildlife along the Aba Huab River Valley by 4x4. O/N Mowani Mtn. Camp B,L,D

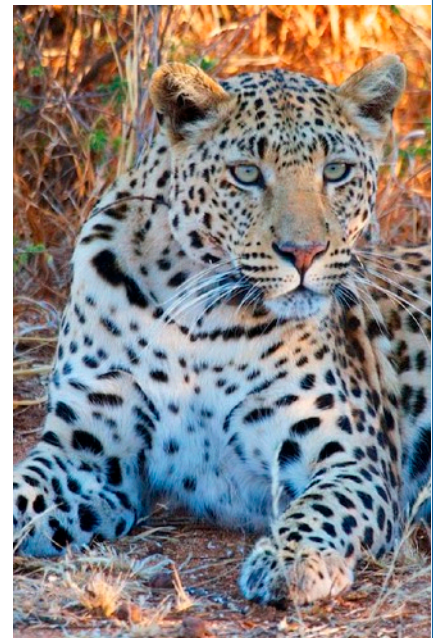
Day 6: Head deeper into Damaraland, stopping at a remote, rarely visited Himba village. The Himbas are nomadic pastoralists and one of the last of the traditional cultures in Namibia. Late afternoon arrival in our camp on the southern border of Etosha National Park O/N Ongave Lodge B,L,D

Day 7: Visit the famed Etosha National Park to see its wide variety of big game animals, including lions,

rhinoceros, zebras, and elephants. The park encompasses an ancient, enormous, seasonal dry lakebed and wildlife in huge numbers visit its waterholes. O/N Ongave Lodge B,L,D

Day 8: Visit the Okonjima Day Center for a short game drive to see cheetahs and leopards. Then take a tour of the AfriCat Foundation, stopping at the local craft market in Okahandja before returning to Windhoek and your lodging for the night. O/N Galton House or similar B,L,D

Day 9: Transfer to the Windhoek airport (included) and your flight home.



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Skeleton Coast

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Day 1: Arrive Windhoek, transfer to hotel Galton House D.

Day 2: Windhoek to Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp

Those electing to continue on the extension will be transferred to the Eros Airport for your scheduled light aircraft flight to Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp. On arrival you will be met by a guide from camp who will transfer you to camp for your three night stay. The afternoon will be spent exploring the Hoanib River, a recovering wildlife refuge.

Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp All nights B,L,D

Day 3: Skeleton Coast Park boundary

Today is spent on activities as arranged by the camp, with local guides. The activities include game drives searching for desert adapted wildlife, guided walks to hide platforms and hiking trails and afternoon drives.

Day 4: Skeleton Coast Park boundary

This morning after breakfast you will go into the Skeleton Coast National Park, boarding a light aircraft for a scenic flight to the coast before landing on the beach--*weather dependent with no refunds if the flight can't take off due to weather as you are not charged additional for the flight. Other activities will be planned for the day.* Continue in a safari vehicle exploring the majestic coastline. After a picnic lunch on the beach and further exploration you will be flown back to Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp in time to relax and enjoy a 'sundowner'.

Day 5: Skeleton Coast Park boundary to Windhoek

This morning after breakfast you will be transferred to the local airstrip for your scheduled light aircraft flight back to Windhoek. You will be met at the airport and

transferred to your night's accommodation.

Day 6: Departure

This morning you will be collected from Galton House and transferred to the International Airport in time for you to catch your outgoing international flight back home.
